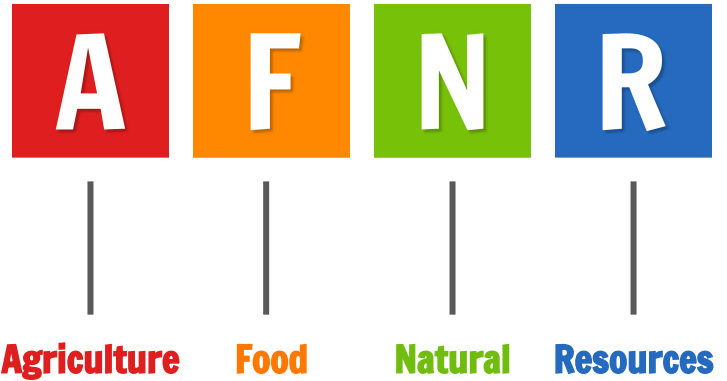




## WHAT IS AFNR?
